Footnotes

PLUG CATCHER stalked the pace three deep, ranged up to engage STANDPOINT nearing the furlong marker, poked his head in front and was inching away. STANDPOINT prompted the pace two wide, forged a narrow lead after a half, battled on gamely thereafter but was unable to resist the winner. WIZARDLY settled in hand, advanced between horses, came three wide to make his bid but failed to make headway through the drive. DYNAMIC IMPACT lunged at the start to get away slow, looped into contention five wide, offered a mild bid but failed to sustain the drive. UNSTOPPABLE COLBY broke slow, was unhurried into stride, angled out leaving the turn and finished with a belated gain. KOWBOY BOOTS was forwardly placed along the inside, but came up empty midway through the turn and faded. MYOSITIS DAN saved ground to little avail. FINAL SAMURAI failed to respond. BROADWAY ZEN set the pressured pace along the inside, was headed with five-sixteenths to run and gave way readily.
