QUIET MAN sprinted clear, set the pace near the rail, repulsed a pair of bids on the second turn, edged off a bit into the stretch then held sway late. VOODOO STORM reserved three wide, advanced four wide on the second turn, made a good move to reach a challenging position in midstretch but went evenly late. SMALL TOWN TALK within striking distance, made a good outside move after a half, challenged the winner from the three path on the second turn but weakened in the drive. THE BEST GLACIER close up while off the inside, was pocketed around the second turn, waited for the runner up to rally past once in the stretch then had no rally. AWESOME BET close up along the inside, moved off the rail on the second turn, held on well to the stretch and tired. NO PLAY closest to the pace while off the inside, challenged between rivals on the second turn but tired in the stretch.
