Footnotes

DROGUE sent to the fore and angled in entering the first turn, settled off of the pace on the backstretch, lacked room leaving the second turn, shifted out entering the stretch, split horses and dropped back to the rail inside the furlong marker, finished with a rush once clear and drew away late. POSITIVELY tracked the pace three wide, drew even leaving the second turn, shook clear entering the stretch, continued on well but was no match for the winner late. MEAN MARINE bumped with KID SIDNEY at the start, was allowed to settle, moved up four wide, loomed a danger entering the stretch, but flattened during the drive and settled for the minor award. AIR SQUADRON settled saving ground, rallied between horses and improved position through the lane. HORNED FROG bobbled at the start, was unhurried into stride, came five wide but lacked a response when called upon. KID SIDNEY was squeezed at the start, lagged at the tail of the field and passed only the tiring ones. SHAKE UP rushed to the lead four wide, set the pace off of the inside to the stretch and gave way readily once headed. SAINT X. attended the pace along the inside, but came up empty before going six furlongs and dropped out.
