Footnotes

THORNHILL, unhurried early, moved inside on the far turn, rallied from the rail into the stretch, then outgamed ALLAMERICAN BEAUTY in the late stages. ALLAMERICAN BEAUTY, well placed near the inside between foes early, angled five wide into the stretch, loomed boldly but was outfinished. GYM KID moved up early to press front-running MOCHA QUEEN three or four wide, gained even terms for the lead in deep stretch but wasn't good enough. SECRET ROMANCE moved in behind horses early, eased out four wide for the drive but was empty the last eighth. MOCHA QUEEN gained the lead early, raced near the inside, managed a slight edge into the final furlong and faltered. LAST WALTZ stalked the pace five wide into the stretch and flattened out. SILVER CALLING, four or five wide most of the way, failed to threaten. LADY AFLAIR, checked behind rivals on the first turn, moved out four or five wide on the backstretch and failed to reach contention. DECEIT tired approaching the stretch.
