Footnotes

OFFLEE WILD, well placed from the start while rated in behind the dueling leaders, angled four or five wide for the drive, took over, then won going away under energetic hand urging. OUTOFTHEBANK went up early to battle for the lead outside of PREMIER ROCKET, headed that one between calls on the turn, lost the edge back to PREMIER ROCKET nearing the stretch, then dug in gamely to save second while no threat to the winner. PREMIER ROCKET gained a slim lead near the inside early, dueled with OUTOFTHEBANK, lost the advantage to that one briefly on the turn, regained it, then grudgingly weakened in the drive. MR. TRUTHFUL, in contention for a half while near the inside, came out four wide for the drive, improved position but couldn't threaten. TARNISHED, outrun for a half, moved six wide into the stretch and couldn't challenge while improving position slightly. MEAN AND NASTY, outrun for a half, made a mild bid to reach contention at the furlong grounds but failed to continue. LOOSAHATCHIE failed to rally. SLEW ROUGE broke slowly, was checked while drifting out, was outrun to the stretch and passed tired foes six or seven wide. FORTY SECOND ST. tired early. DRIVING MUSIC moved in behind horses early, raced in contention three or four wide for a half and tired. FRENCH LIEUTENANT faded concluding the turn while four or five wide. HYBLA TWO was outrun.
