### Footnotes

REAL APPEAL, unhurried early and four wide, swung out six wide when advancing into the stretch, then closed determinedly under urging to wear down KING'S SILVER SON while leaning in and exchanging bumps with that one at the end. KING'S SILVER SON, never far back and in hand four wide, moved five wide into the stretch, gained a slight edge between calls in the final furlong, then couldn't contain the winner's surge while coming out a bit and bumping with that one at the wire. TIZZY came out bumping AQUARIAN at the start which put that one in tight quarters, gained the lead near the inside, went along under careful handling, showed the way into the final furlong, came out about the sixteenth pole forcing AQUARIAN to steady, then grudgingly weakened. AQUARIAN, in tight after the start, raced along the inside under rating, lacked room at the quarter-mile ground, continued inside, eased out between rivals, was forced to steady at the sixteenth pole when TIZZY came out, then lacked a final account. MAPMAKER tracked the pace four wide to the stretch and came up empty. RIDE THE WHIZ forced the pace into the upper stretch and weakened while three or four wide. MORE THAN A REASON raced four wide and failed to rally in an even effort. UNSTOPPABLE FORCE tired on the far turn. VALADOUR was outrun. STAR CANYON never was prominent.
