Footnotes

RICH HERO went up early to track front-running READY IN THE MORN four wide in hand, moved steadily to take over in the upper stretch, drew clear and was under mild encouragement to hold sway. DIXIE DECISION, unhurried early, raced in behind foes, advanced between horses three or four wide into the final furlong and was all out to earn the place. SIR JOCK, up close early, settled three or four wide, angled to the rail for the final furlong and couldn't make up the difference. BOSS LAFITTE stalked the pace four or five wide, raced within easy striking distance into the final furlong and came up empty. READY IN THE MORN gained the lead inside early, drew off three wide entering the backstretch, showed the way to the head of the stretch and faltered in the drive. OLDHAM raced near the inside and was empty. CORNWHISKEY broke awkwardly, leaned in bumping CAUSATION, raced in a striking position between foes three or four wide to the stretch and weakened. CAUSATION, bumped at the start by CORNWHISKEY, raced three wide most of the way and never threatened. SPLISH never was prominent. SOTTOMARINO broke slowly and was always outrun.
