Footnotes

APTITUDE leaned in at the start bumping I'M HOWLIN, settled in hand while racing four or five wide, commenced his rally three furlongs out, lugged in at the furlong grounds while soundly shaken up with the whip lefthanded, caught front-running SOLDIERS FORTUNE leaving the sixteenth pole and won going way under vigorous hand urging. SOLDIERS FORTUNE, rated along the inside from early on, moved to the fore early on the second turn, settled into the final furlong with a clear advantage but wasn't a match for APTITUDE. I'M HOWLIN bumped from both sides at the start, settled within striking distance, moved with the winner while inside that one on the second turn but failed to sustain the needed momentum. GOLDEN NICOLAS broke in the air, moved to the fore soon after, made the pace while racing four wide until early on the second turn and weakened gradually. EARTH SHAKING broke in front, settled within easy striking distance but faded on the second turn. PROPER TERMS wasn't a factor. CAREFREE came out at the start bumping I'M HOWLIN, raced between foes in a contending position to the far turn and weakened gradually.
