Footnotes

LEAD STORY settled in behind the dueling leaders early, rallied from the rail into the stretch and drove clear in the final furlong under brisk urging. UNSURPASSED went up early to press front-running IN THE LEAD four wide, stuck a head in front in the upper stretch between calls but couldn't match strides with the winner late as second best. IN THE LEA gained a narrow advantage early, raced three wide, made the pace until the final quarter and weakened. WEALTHY BELONGINGS, within striking distance four or five wide into the stretch, was empty in the drive. DYNA PENNY settled three or four wide, raced in contention to the lane but was empty when straightened for the drive. CHAP UP, four or five wide, raced within striking distance for six furlongs and weakened.
