STAKES Iroquois S. Grade 3 - Thoroughbred

FOR TWO YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$100 each on or before October 14, 2006 or by supplementary nomination of \$5,000 each at time of entry. \$500 to pass the entry box; \$500 additional to start, with \$100,000 added. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight 123 lbs. Non-winners of a graded sweepstakes allowed 2 lbs.; a sweepstakes, 4 lbs.; two races other than claiming 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. All supplementary nominations will be required to pay entry and starting fees if they participate. Trophy to winning owner. Closed Saturday, October 14, 2006 with 34 nominations.

TIZ WONDERFUL, steadied repeatedly when leaving the chute between foes, edged near the inside to vie for the lead, battled with INCRIMINATE while inside that one to the stretch, drew clear and expanded her advantage under energetic handling. WHAT A TALE settled near the inside, was never far back, came out five wide for the drive and couldn't menace the winner while fully extended to earn the place. STARBASE forced the pace early while four wide, raced close up into the lane, was just off the winner for the drive but came up empty. INCRIMINATE contested the pace from early on while three or four wide, battled forwardly outside the winner to the stretch and weakened. OFFICER ROCKET (GB), within striking distance and between horses four or five wide, offered no closing bid. PASSPORT raced five wide and wasn't a factor. SHORE was finished after a half.
