NATIVE RULER close up three wide, angled out for the drive, challenged inside the final furlong and edged off late. GRAND TRAVERSE never far back four wide, challenged after a half and held on gamely to be second best while not quite up to handling the winner late. NEVERBEENDANCIN' forced the pace three wide, gained a short lead on the turn, held on well to the final furlong and tired. TIMBUCTO contested the pace off the inside and tired. SILVER LORD outrun early, raced in the three path and could not threaten. MITIGATION forwardly placed along the inside, faded.
