Footnotes

BIRTHDAY SONG angled in early to contest the pace four wide, duelled with HIGH SPEED ACCESS until approaching the stretch, took over, then was hard ridden to move clear late. ROSE HUNTER, within striking distance and five wide, moved wider entering the upper stretch, couldn't reach the winner but outgamed THIN AIR for second. THIN AIR tracked the pace four or five wide, loomed prominently into the final furlong and came up empty. HIGH SPEED ACCESS gained a slight edge inside early, battled with the winner while inside that one to the lane and weakened. SEATTLE WEEKEND, outrun until approaching the stretch, made a mild bid into the upper stretch but failed to sustain the needed momentum. SINGIT, well placed between horses three or four wide into the stretch, flattened out when the test came. KEY TO THE CAT, outrun to the stretch, passed tired foes. CAPE TOWN LASS filed to reach contention. POUT failed to menace. RUSH NOTE, well placed inside for six furlongs, weakened thereafter. LOVE EM N LEAVE EM was never prominent. SPELLFIRE faded after a half.
