STRAIGHT LINE, bumped at the start by BRITT'S JULES when that one drifted in, was never far back, tracked the dueling leaders four wide, inched to the front nearing the final furlong and was hard ridden the remainder. VICARAGE went up at once to attend the pace four wide, gained a slight edge, opened a clear advantage between calls nearing the final quarter, was engaged by the winner from the outside in the upper stretch and couldn't keep pace as second best. LEVEL PLAYINGFIELD, never far back and four or five wide, came a bit wider when straightened for the drive, loomed a solid threat for the final furlong but lacked a late response. GO NOW settled near the inside early, was asked for more three furlongs out, worked his way out six wide for the drive but couldn't muster a late bid. NAKAYAMA KUN, outrun for a half while four wide, circled horses ten or twelve wide into the lane and improved position while unable to seriously menace. ARTEMUS SUNRISE, nicely positioned near the the inside early, moved between foes four wide entering the upper stretch but flattened out when straightened for the drive. NKOSI REIGNS raced within easy striking distance four or five wide for five furlongs and weakened. STERLING GOLD, in contention five wide for a half, weakened thereafter. BRITT'S JULES drifted in at the start bumping the winner, went up to contest the pace three wide, battled forwardly for five furlongs and tired.
