SWEET NANETTE gained the lead inside at the start, was carefully handled early, drew off in the upper stretch and was under intermittent urging in the drive. DESIGNER PHONE bore in at the start bumping EVIL, was never far back, ranged up outside the winner for the drive but couldn't menace as second best. CASANOVA MARKER, well placed inside into the stretch, angled out for the drive but couldn't challenge the top two. EVIL, bumped at the start and forced in, raced in contention into the stretch but was empty. UPPER ECHELON, outrun early, made a mild bid to reach contention concluding the turn but lacked a further response. RUNNING PAM, outrun into the stretch, wasn't a threat while passing tired ones. TWENTY TWO KISSES failed to menace in an even effort. WHITE HOT stalked the pace for a half and tired. PARTY RAGE was outrun. SPIRIT OF EMILY was done early. AFTERNOON BREEZE, bumped at the start, gave way approaching the stretch.
