PREMIUM SALTINE sprinted clear near the inside early, made the balance of the pace and widened as much the best under mild hand urging. TOUCHDOWN KY came out bumping with LINC after the start, chased the winner four wide throughout and was second best. FAST SPOT, seven or eight wide on the backstretch, edged in a bit on the turn, continued within striking distance into the final furlong while five or six wide but came up empty. TIMBER LEGEND, outrun inside to the stretch, came out from between rivals five wide entering the final furlong and improved position while not a threat. LINC, bumped at the start and checked, raced four wide and failed to rally. ARCOLA LANE, in contention while between foes six or seven wide on the backstretch, angled in a bit on the turn but faltered in the drive. STEVI'S SONG stalked the pace four or five wide to the stretch and tired. CHART THE COURSE moved near the inside on the turn and tired.
