**Footnotes**

MAYBE LIN, never far back while racing in behind horses, was four wide on the turn, angled inside the leaders when straightened for the drive and closed determinedly under pressure to be along in time. RED DICE, close up five wide early, took over on the turn, opened a clear lead, then failed to last. PHAT, outrun early and six wide, moved six wide into the stretch and was gaining late. CINDY'S HOBBY, outsprinted early, made a run from between foes five wide into the final furlong but failed to sustain the needed momentum. SMOKEY DREAMS, within striking distance inside, lacked a closing account. MISS HONEYBEE, five or six wide, flattened out the last eighth. DASHING GIRL wasn't a threat and raced six wide into the stretch. GLITTER TWICE failed to menace. BARE LEGS vied for the lead between foes four wide but tired upon going a half. GORGEOUS LAKE gained a slim lead early while dueling three wide, surrendered the advantage to RED DICE on the turn, gave way, was pulled up appearing lame in the left-front leaving the eighth pole, then vanned off.
