Footnotes

KITTY'S LEGEND settled in behind horses early, moved between foes four wide at the quarter-mile ground, then proved gamely best under strong handling. BAYANI, bumped at the start and unhurried early, advanced five wide approaching the stretch, reached the front a furlong out while racing outside the winner, then was outfinished. FOOTLIGHTS, outrun for six furlongs, came out seven or eight wide for the drive and offered a mild gain. BABETH (BRZ), within striking distance and saving ground to the stretch, angled six wide for the drive and improved position while unable to menace. WILD BUT WORTH IT went up early to press front-running ALI ONLINE three or four wide, gained the advantage approaching the final quarter but faltered in the drive. TEMPUS FUGIT, rated along in behind the leaders from early on, angled four wide for the drive and flattened out the last eighth. PROMENADE ON IN tracked the pace four wide to the stretch and tired. ALL AT ONCE never reached contention after breaking slowly. GREENBACK GAL was outrun. ALI ONLINE drifted out at the start bumping BAYANI, gained the lead inside, made the pace for almost six furlongs and faded.
