Footnotes

FOREBEARER, never far back and four or five wide, swept to the front in the upper stretch, drew clear, then was kept to his task to hold sway. BULLET RAIN, bumped at the start by ACCREDITATION and squeezed back, was outrun for three furlongs, fanned out six wide for the drive and was going well at the end. MYSTERY GUEST, always well placed and four wide, couldn't muster the needed late response. FIESTA TEXAS angled in early to duel outside of DREAM CASE for the lead, gained a slight edge, battled up close into the stretch and weakened. BONWELL stalked the dueling leaders four or five wide into the final furlong and came up empty. COSTALEGRE, within striking distance along the inside to the stretch, angled four or five wide for the drive and failed to fire. SULTRY BIDDER had no rally in an even effort. LA BALA failed to menace and raced four or five wide. DREAM CASE battled for the lead along the inside until nearing the final quarter and tired. ACCREDITATION, bumped at the break by LORD BUCKY and forced in on BULLET RAIN, never was prominent. LORD BUCKY stumbled at the start, swerved in on ACCREDITATION, forced that one in on BULLET RAIN, then was outrun.
