JEDI CODE stumbled while breaking sluggishly, settled inside, came around a tiring GREAT ATTITUDE nearing the final quarter, briefly awaited room at the three-sixteenth pole, then, when clear along the rail, won going away under mild hand urging with the jockey glancing back to the outside in the late going as much the best. MASTERWORK, never far back, advanced between foes our or five wide into the stretch and was second best. BIKER BOY pressed front-running MR. WINCHESTER from early on three wide, took over in the upper stretch but couldn't sustain the needed momentum. A. U. MINER, outrun for a half, came out seven wide for the final furlong and bested the others. FISHERMAN'S WHARF, in contention five wide into the final furlong, failed to fire. MR. WINCHESTER gained the lead two wide, made the pace to the head of the stretch and couldn't continue. MACKINAW raced in a striking position five wide into the upper stretch and failed to rally. HIDDEN BAY had no rally. CLASSIC EMPIRE raced in contention near the inside to the stretch and weakened. E FACTOR was through after a half. ARELI tracked the pace four wide for a half and weakened. GREAT ATTITUDE faded on the turn.
