STORMING MARINE pressed the pace off the inside, responded willingly in the stretch and proved narrowly best. FOREVER CAT set the pace inside, responded willingly when headed in midstretch and held on gamely but was outfinished. VALTRUS prompted the pace three wide, gained a short lead with a furlong to go and held on gamely while not quite good enough. WARN outrun along the inside, advanced along the inside on the second turn, angled out a bit with a furlong to go, came out move near the sixteenth marker and closed well. EL ALEMAN within striking distance off the inside, moved out four wide midway though the second turn but lacked a late bid. YAROSLAV reserved along the inside, moved off the rail for the second turn, maintained good position into the stretch but lodged only a mild late bid. HOLY ANTHEM outrun off the rail, was no real threat. BROGANVILLE within striking distance three wide, tired. DARBOY within reach early three wide, was fanned six wide into the stretch and had no late bid. BIG WIG close up along the inside, angled out for the drive but tired.
