Footnotes

SOBER LIVING settled in hand off of the inside, shifted out four wide to make a bold bid, reeled in the leaders nearing the furlong marker and quickly drew clear. MARCH MARY was allowed to settle, advanced between horses after the opening quarter, ranged up three wide to engage for the lead leaving the turn but was unable to match strides with the winner through the drive. MRS. SENTEL opened clear to set the pace off of the inside, drifted in to the rail in the stretch, was no match for the winner but just failed to hold the place. RUTH AND NEVA chased the pace three wide, but weakened in the final furlong and faded. SOTO'S HIJA broke slow, was unhurried into stride, angled out to make a mild gain but failed to threaten. SAINT GOLD attended the pace along the inside, was hemmed in entering the stretch, found room inside the furlong marker but lacked a response once clear. TELMA broke slow, tucked in to save ground but was never a factor. INTERNET CAFE was fractious in the gate, came away a step slow and showed little. RUNBELLAMYRUN was through early.
