GRAND SENSATION close up four wide, challenged from that path on the turn and proved best under pressure. COOSADA outprinted early, raced in the three path on the turn, angled out a bit for the drive and closed well late to dead heat with DE PRICE. DE PRICE within striking distance in the three path, finished willingly outside the leaders and finished on even terms with COOSADA. DEVIL TRAIN closest to the pace while off the inside, challenged on the turn, gained a short lead approaching the stretch and held on gamely. GLINT forwardly placed, challenged from the three path on the turn, battled into midstretch and weakened late. LOOKN MIGHTY FAST within striking distance four wide, angled out for the drive but lodged only a mild bid. OUR DARK KNIGHT outrun early, raced in the four path on the turn, came to the outside for the drive but was no real threat. DONE GONE rushed to the lead, set the pace along the inside and faded.
