DANCE FOR THEE, never far back while stalking the dueling leaders and saving ground to the stretch, angled out for the drive, wrested command, was lightly roused with the whip, then widened under hand urging with the jockey flashing his whip on the right side. HIGHFALUTIN, close up inside from the start, loomed prominently inside the leaders entering the stretch but wasn't a match for the winner. BRUSH WITH TEQUILA bobbled sharply at the start, quickly recovered to the gain the lead from the outside, battled with HIGHFALUTIN, made the pace into the stretch and weakened. RUNUP THE COLORS moved inside early, then saved ground to no avail in a dull account. VALID BONNET raced in a striking position to the stretch and came up empty. THREE FANFARES, outrun until the stretch, failed to menace while seven wide in the drive. FOUNTAIN SQUARE bobbled sharply at the start and tired approaching the stretch.
