Footnotes

GENTEEL, unhurried inside early, saved ground for six furlongs, angled outside front-running GOLD EMPRESS four wide, took over, then was kept to her task to drive clear while drifting out late. DEFAMATION, never far back while following the leaders four or five wide, angled in behind horses in the upper stretch, split foes four wide in the final furlong and earned second. SYMBOL OF LOVE, within easy striking distance while four or five wide, moved six or seven wide into the stretch, loomed prominently but couldn't muster the needed response. SUNDAY SPORT came out at the break bumping CLASSIKAS, went up soon after to track front-running GOLD EMPRESS while four wide, continued forwardly into the lane and weakened. GOLD EMPRESS gained the lead early, raced near the inside, settled into the stretch with a clear advantage and faltered. EXHIBIT, in contention while in behind the leaders three wide into the lane, came up empty. GRANDPA'S GRAY stalked the pace three or four wide until approaching the stretch and tired. TAKE ME HOME LADY failed to menace. CLASSIKAS, bumped from both sides at the start, was outrun. ROAD QUEEN never was close. MAYBEFOREAL leaned in at the start bumping CLASSIKAS, then failed to menace.
