Footnotes

EXPLOITED STORM vied for the lead inside PURE early, fell back around the turn, eased out four wide for the drive and was hard ridden to prevail. PURE battled with the winner from early on while outside that one, took over, drew well clear, then couldn't contain EXPLOITED STORM in the late going. GO NOW, outsprinted early, rallied between rivals four wide into the stretch and was going well at the end. CATASCATCAN, never far back, moved inside, rallied near the rail into the lane and couldn't sustain the needed momentum. SILVER WARRANT, bumped at the start, offered a mild gain. TACTICAL PRINCE, shut off at the start, rushed to contention inside, continued forwardly to the stretch and weakened. FARNUM ALLEY ducked out at the start and jolted THORNWOOD, was outrun to the lane and passed tired foes. CHICAGO GOLD stalked the pace five wide into the lane and flattened out. MIGHTY SEDONA well placed to the stretch while three or four wide, weakened thereafter. OKAHUMPKA (GB), bumped at the start and forced out on SILVER WARRANT, never was prominent. THORNWOOD, bumped at the break by FARNUM ALLEY and forced out, was never a factor. TRIESTE CAT broke down just before going a half.
