After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight 123 lbs. Non-winners of a graded sweepstakes allowed 2 lbs.; a sweepstakes, 4 lbs.; two races other than claiming, 6 lbs. **Footnotes**

CAPT. CANDYMAN CAN prompted the pace between horses, assumed command with seven-sixteenths to run, shook off MONTY'S BEST inside the furlong marker and opened clear through the final yards. MONTY'S BEST was well placed three wide, ranged up to engage the winner entering the stretch, was unable to match strides with that one through the drive but continued on willingly to hold the place safely. STAR OF DAVID pulled to contention from between horses, was tucked in behind the leaders on the backstretch under steady restraint, angled out to be clear entering the stretch, made a mild bid but lacked the needed late response. GRESHAM settled in the second flight, came three wide to make a mild rally but failed to seriously threaten. BRAVE VICTORY was allowed to settle into stride, made a middle move three wide to close the gap, came four wide into the stretch but came up empty in the drive. CASEY'S ON CALL was away alertly to set the pressured pace to the turn and weakened. JUST LIKE BISCUIT showed little. CHILLINESS trailed.
