DRYFLY set the pace inside, responded willingly when headed in midstretch and drew clear late. FLATTER THAN ME close up three wide, lodged a mild bid to be up for the place. GREAT ATTACK closest to the pace off the inside, challenged once in the stretch, gained a short lead approaching the furlong marker but faltered late. HARKEN UP outrun early, moved out three wide late on the turn, came wider for the drive but made only a mild late gain. PEGASUS PRANCER outrun off the inside, could not menace. BACKWATER BLUES within striking distance off the rail, tired. Z. I. ZIPP fractious in the gate, was forwardly placed four wide and tired. SOUNDMAN could not menace along the inside. ALWAYS WILDCATIN' forwardly placed along the inside, tired. YOU ALREADY KNOW was outrun four wide. SIR WALTER'S ORO reared at the start unseating his rider.
