ARRESTED DREAMS, forwardly placed and five wide on the backstretch under light restraint, took over when straightened into the stretch, moved clear, then edged away late under strong handling. ELECTRIC SHOCK, within easy striking distance while racing in between foes behind the leaders, came out five wide for the drive, made a bold run nearing the furlong grounds but failed to sustain the needed momentum. CASTLE BLAZE, forwardly placed in hand from early on, lacked room nearing the final quarter and was checked, angled out five wide, altered course back inside the top two when clear in the final furlong but wasn't good enough. IT'S AN ECHO pressed pacesetting MARSHESLEW from early on, headed that one nearing the stretch but faltered when straightened for the drive. ASLEWOFWHITE, four wide on the backstretch, was outrun. MARSHESLEW, wearing a nasal strip, gained the lead inside early, made the pace for nearly six furlongs and gave way badly in the drive.
