Footnotes

BEST FOOT FORWARD, rated between foes early, angled five wide into the stretch, wrested command and was kept to her task. GRINDSTONE COWGIRL, forwardly placed inside, gained the advantage from the rail on the turn but wasn't a match for the winner in the drive. COZY COED, outrun to the stretch, made a bid to reach contention at the furlong grounds and failed to continue. YOU CAN'T HIDE, outrun early, worked her way inside, reached contention in the upper stretch and lacked a further response. SIX RIBBONS, well placed five wide early, lost position on the turn and continued extremely wide in the stretch. BEDEVIL raced near the inside in a striking position in the stretch and flattened out. SKY HEIRESS was done early. LOCO LAURA tired after a half. ASCOT GIRL tracked the pace for a half while four or five wide and tired. ROMAN RIPPLES, used early five wide, was finished after three furlongs. AMERICAN DREAMS sprinted clear early, raced three wide and gave way readily upon going a half.
