Footnotes

FABULOSITY, in hand early while tracking the leaders four wide, took over midway on the turn, settled into the stretch with a clear advantage and was kept to her task in the drive. GHAZADA gained a forward position early while three or four wide, angled six wide for the drive, loomed prominently outside the winner through the final furlong and wasn't good enough. S TABLE DANCER drifted in at the start bumping BRUSHED DUSTY, raced with in striking distance always near the inside, eased out five or six wide for the drive but couldn't offer the needed response. NEPOTISM, in contention off the inside, could gain only slightly in the drive. PHONE JOAN gained the lead three wide early, made the pace until approaching the stretch and weakened. SUNSHINE SUMMER, in contention throughout, failed to rally in an even effort. ARCANA, bumped at the start and steadied, was outrun to the stretch and improved position while never a threat. KATZE FRAU edged in early to track the leaders three or four wide and weakened approaching the final quarter. TOO CLEVER, bumped at the break by MARK OF PERFECTION, went up early to press front-running PHONE JOAN four wide and weakened upon going

six furlongs. MARK OF PERFECTION drifted in at the start bumping TOO CLEVER, then failed to reach contention. MODERN MARVEL never was prominent. BRUSHED DUSTY, bumped at the start by S TABLE DANCER and forced in, always was outrun.
