Footnotes

MORLANA, unhurried early, raced in behind the leaders, rallied from the rail leaving the eighth pole and was all out to be up in time. TRESSEL gained the advantage early, raced under careful handling three wide, opened a clear lead entering the lane, then was outnoddod. SUTTON'S BAY, always well placed while racing between horses four wide, loomed menacingly through the final sixteenth and was outfinished. REITO PEITO, nicely positioned near the inside between foes, continued within easy striking distance into the last eighth and failed to fire. SUGAR BOOGER broke in the air, settled three wide, came out six or seven wide entering the lane and offered a minor gain. NORTHERN VACATION, in front after the break, forced the pace three or four wide to the stretch and weakened. SWEEPIT drifted at the start, was straightened and positioned in behind rivals, raced four or five wide to the stretch and failed to rally. DYNABIN, reserved after the break when in slightly close quarters, failed to seriously menace. SOBRESALIENTE broke in the air, gained a contending position five wide, continued within striking distance into the upper stretch and flattened out. TIP TOP stalked the pace five or six wide for six furlongs and tired.
