Footnotes

GUN IT, rated in behind the dueling leaders early, moved inside, rallied from the rail, took over entering the upper stretch, quickly moved clear and widened under strong handling. FAITH'S MAGIC tracked the pace four wide early, fell back slightly and moved in behind rivals on the far turn, came out five wide for the drive and was second best. MCANDREWS, steadied in tight quarters soon after the start, raced near the inside, maneuvered three wide entering the upper stretch and failed to gain at the end. VOCABULARY vied for the lead near the inside early, was briefly clear on the backstretch, held on well until the final quarter and weakened. EYE CATCHER, reserved early and near the inside to the head of the stretch, angled five wide into the stretch but failed to gain in the final furlong. MAXIMUM PRECISION, never far back and near the inside, flattened out in the drive. ISNT HE, unhurried into the backstretch and four or five wide, inched up on the far turn but failed to continue the bid. BALLACOLLA broke slowly, raced four or five wide and failed to rally. IMPRESSIVE COMMAND slow to start, never reached contention. SERAC raced forwardly three abreast for six furlongs and tired. WAKE FOREST attended the pace early while between foes, held on well to the far turn and faded.
