Footnotes

LOOKS THE PART gained a narrow lead three wide early, dueled GOOD MORNING NELL while outside that one, remained off the inside for the drive and held sway under urging. GOOD MORNING NELL, up close inside the winner most of the way, was fully extended to save the place. BETTERN BISCUITS, forwardly placed and five wide, couldn't produce a final response. HOUR QUEEN, outsprinted early, advanced four wide into the stretch and couldn't sustain the needed momentum. CUZSHESCOZY bobbed at the start, went up to attend the pace between horses and weakened when straightened into the lane. CLEAR CONSCIENCE, sluggish to begin, moved out six wide on the backstretch and never was a factor. SKIPPY O failed to menace. LADY DAY hopped at the start, was hustled along to force the pace four wide, continued forwardly for a half and weakened.
