TERRIFIC STORM, never far back and four or five wide, closed determinedly under urging to wear down JUNIOR COLLEGE in the late going. JUNIOR COLLEGE, fractious in the gate prior to the start, moved to the front at once, made the pace two wide, was clear for the last eighth, then could not contain the winner's surge. LOOSE LEAF pressed front-running JUNIOR COLLEGE from the beginning while three wide, loomed boldly between the top two at the end and wasn't good enough. NORTHERN SCENE, never far back and in hand along the inside to the stretch, remained two wide for the final eighth and lacked the needed response. SIDCUP, reserved three wide early, fanned five wide leaving the second turn but couldn't offer the needed response. I'M WAITING FOR U, two wide and within striking distance into the lane, came up empty. ROMNEY MARSH always was outrun.
