Footnotes

BILLY close up inside, angled off the rail on the backstretch, moved closer on the second turn, drifted to the inside with a sixteenth to go and finished willingly to be up in time. CLAYTON'S LUCK forced the pace three wide., challenged in earnest after a half, gained a short lead in upper stretch and held on gamely to miss. LAKE PLEASANT swerved in after the start and brushed the inside rail, was outrun early, angled out and made a good five wide run on the second turn, reached a forward position approaching the stretch but could not sustain the bid. SARKOZY unhurried for a half, took up entering the second turn when in tight, recovered and improved his position while no threat. DABOSSMAN outrun for five furlongs, advanced five wide thereafter but lacked a late bid. INDIANAPOLIS (BRZ) broke slowly and was outrun, moved up in the three path on the second turn but could not threaten. JOHNNY CADILLAC unhurried for a half, made a bold four wide middle move but could not sustain the bid. HOBBY vied for the early lead three wide, held on well to the stretch and tired. BALLACOLLA prominent four wide, faded. ROSA PANTERA stumbled at the start, was reserved early and could not menace. GIFT COUPON was no threat. SATYRS forced the pace along the inside and stopped.
