H. J. ARVIN was away alertly to dictate terms, dug in gamely to meet the challenge of MINED with a furlong to run, turned back that one and kicked clear. HURLING was allowed to settle, circled four wide and finished willingly to earn the place. MINED prompted the pace three wide, drew even entering the stretch, loomed large but failed to sustain the drive. SOUPED UP FAST was forwardly placed between horses through the opening half, then along the inside thereafter, but weakened after six furlongs and faded. MAJOR WINTERS was unhurried, got through between horses and finished with a belated gain. THE BERRY EDGE was allowed to settle, moved up between horses on the second turn to make a mild bid but faltered entering the stretch. WICKLOW COUNTY broke slow, was rank to place along the inside and was never a factor. IT'S ALL ABOUT JOY showed little in a dull effort.
