ANECDOTE set the pace off the inside, repulsed a bid by LAY UP on the turn, drew clear into the stretch and stayed clear under steady urging. ISLAND BOUND within striking distance, moved to the inside midway through the turn, angled out a bit for the drive but lodged only a mild late bid. STORM CLOUD COMING outspurred early, advanced in the three path on the turn, angled out leaving the turn but lacked a late bid. LAY UP forced the pace three wide, held on well to the stretch and tired. SQUARE ENERGY close up four wide, gave way. ELLUSIVE WILDCAT stumbled at the start, was unhurried inside and never threatened. DON'T CHANGE was no factor while off the inside. MARIGO forwardly placed four wide, stopped.
