D. C. GENE opened clear to set the pace, was collared nearing the furlong marker, fought back gamely and came again to prevail. SUDDEN WAR (ARG)

broke slow, settled in hand, split horses to make a bold bid four wide, forged command with a furlong to run, but drifted in through the drive, bumped GOLD BELLS SPIN and was unable to best the determined winner. DISTORTED DAVE stalked the pace four wide, came five wide and was along in time to earn the show. GOLD BELLS SPIN stalked the pace three wide, drew even near the furlong marker, was put in tight and bumped when SUDDEN WAR (ARG) came in, steadied and lost his best chance. DOCTOR MARK was close up three wide to the stretch and weakened. MAJOR WINTERS broke slow, was allowed to settle, angled out and finished with a mild rally. TOUCH ME QUICK broke slow, was unhurried, finished with a belated gain but failed to threaten. SONG OF LIFE contended along the inside for six furlongs and tired. ELLENBERGER PARK passed the tiring ones. NEED MONEY DAD saved ground to little avail. GRATITAT was unhurried into stride four wide and was never a factor. ADARO settled five wide and was through early. The Stewards conducted an inquiry into the stretch run involving SUDDEN WAR (ARG) and GOLD BELLS SPIN, and for drifting and taking the path of GOLD BELLS SPIN. SUDDEN WAR (ARG) was disqualified from second and placed fourth.
