FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$100 each or by supplementary nomination of \$5,000 each by 12:00 noon (EST) Thursday, October 25, 2012. \$500 to pass the entry box; \$500 additional to start, with \$100,000 added. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weights to be announced Friday, October 26, 2012. The maximum numbers of starters for the Ack Ack Handicap will be limited to fourteen (14). If more than fourteen (14) entries pass the entry box preference will be given to highweights, with consideration to the scale of weights for age. Any horse excluded from running because of the aforementioned preference shall be refunded the entry fee and supplementary nomination fee if applicable. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. All supplementary nominations will be required to pay entry and starting fees if they participate. Trophy to winning owner. Closed, Wednesday, October 17, 2012 with 29 nominations.

Footnotes

NECK 'N NECK was unhurried in hand, shifted out near the seven-sixteenths pole, made a sweeping move five, took over with three-sixteenths to run, edged clear and held safely. FORT LOUDON contested the pace three wide, was unable to match strides with the winner but fought on well between horses and held the place. STEALCASE stalked the pace three wide, angled in near the furlong marker and was making up ground. SERUNI stalked the pace, bid four wide between horses but was unable to improve position. DOMINUS disputed the pace off of the inside, but faltered between horses in the stretch and faded. ZIMMER was unhurried into stride, angled out leaving the turn but lacked a response when called upon. GRAND BERRY (ARG) was close up off of the inside for five furlongs and stopped.
