EAGLE SOUL dueled along the inside, shook off CANNONBALL CHAMP before going a half, was tackled again by EARLY SUCCESS nearing the furlong marker, met the challenge in valiant fashion and held sway. EARLY SUCCESS stalked the pace in hand, launched a bold bid entering the stretch, came to level terms with a furlong to run, continued on willingly but was unable to best the determined winner. EGYPTIAN WARRIOR was allowed to settle, advanced between horses through the turn, shifted out nearing the furlong marker but settled for the minor award. TRANSYLVANIA FLASH settled saving ground, angled out entering the stretch and improved position. GOODNIGHT DIVA was fractious in the gate, broke slow and was unhurried into stride, came seven wide and finished with a belated gain. BENNY BOY was close up along the inside, bore out through the turn and fought restraint, leveled into stride entering the stretch but came up empty during the drive. M ONE made a middle move five wide, weakened during the drive, steadied when EGYPTIAN WARRIOR came out and retreated. CANNONBALL CHAMP dueled three wide, but came up empty between horses before going a half and dropped out. LEOTA KEY was erratic into stride, dropped well back and trailed.
