Footnotes

TEMPESTINA, unruly behind the gate prior to the start, went up early to stalk the leaders three abreast, took over from that position in the upper stretch, drew off when sharply roused and was gathered up late as much the best. ALERT EM, outrun for a half, saved ground into the stretch, came out to rally from between foes five wide leaving the eighth pole and offered a mild gain. STORM GALE ducked in at the start and bumped hard with BOOT UM BERTIE, recovered to race in a striking position to the stretch but couldn't seriously menace in the drive while improving position. MOUNTAIN SNOW, difficult to load into the gate, went up to press the pace soon after the start, gained a narrow edge entering the stretch but weakened soon after. COSTUME, outrun until the stretch, couldn't menace while improving position. PACIFIC SALT gained a slight edge inside early, held on while dueling until the stretch and weakened gradually. FOREST SONG wasn't a factor in an even effort. BOOT UM BERTIE, bumped soundly from both sides at the start, recovered to gain a striking position five wide but was finished upon going a half. SPREE, wearing a nasal strip, stalked the leaders for a half while saving ground, swung out five wide for the drive but tired. ROENA was outrun. STORMIN CAT was finished early. MARIANNE BIT, wearing a nasal strip, ducked out at the start bumping BOOT UM BERTIE, raced wide early and was never close.
