Footnotes

ALISIOS gained the lead at the start, settled on the lead under a long rating hold, managed a narrow advantage into the stretch, then increased his margin under energetic handling. TUZINAMA RUN, forwardly placed from the start while racing in behind the winner, angled outside of ALISIOS in the final furlong but couldn't muster the needed response. BOLD CALEB went up early to stalk the winner from the outside, loomed menacingly entering the stretch but couldn't produce the needed response. SILVER ON SILVER, outrun early, reached contention concluding the second turn, came out five or six wide for the drive but flattened out late. AVIGATOR, off sluggishly while brushing the side of the gate, appeared a bit rank while in behind the leaders while racing between horses, raced in a striking position into the stretch but came up empty. MAKE YOUR MARK, outrun for six furlongs, came out seven wide for the stretch run but couldn't offer a serious response. JOLEUR, fractious in the gate prior to the start, saved ground but tired. FERROSO (CHI), unhurried early, made a bold run five wide approaching the final quarter but flattened out when straightened for the drive. SINGING ALONG tired after stalked the leaders five wide to the stretch. JUNEAU TRAIL, off a bit slow, raced six or seven wide much of the way and wasn't prominent.
