Footnotes

TWO DOT SLEW gained the lead early, was able to work her way inside by the end of the backstretch, moved clear, made the balance of the pace, attempted to lug in slightly in the late going and was under mild encouragement to widen. TAYLORS ANGEL came out at the start bumping FREE AND FOOLISH, recovered to race in contention, angled five wide for the drive and couldn't menace the winner while fully extended. COMING TO TOWN, well placed inside into the stretch, was empty the last eighth. DENZIL'SFIRSTBABY leaned in about the five furlong marker and soundly exchanged bumps with NASKRA'S REASON, continued forwardly four wide into the stretch but lacked a closing response. GROOVY ANSWER, well placed along the inside into the stretch, failed to offer a further account. DIXIE DANCING, outrun until the stretch, improved position while unable to menace. NASKRA'S REASON came out about the five-eighths pole and exchanged bumps with DENZIL'SFIRSTBABY and failed to menace. FREE AND FOOLISH, bumped from both sides at the start, wasn't a serious factor. DEVIL'S MAMA worked her way in early to stalk the leaders five wide, held on well until the stretch and weakened. ROYAL INDISCRETION, sluggish to begin, was never close. MISS CHRIS stumbled at the start and leaned in bumping FREE AND FOOLISH, then was outrun. NORMA'S CASH CROP, slow to start, was wide throughout and never close.
