Footnotes

FLIRTATIOUS, rated in behind the leaders early, edged closer on the second turn, came out five wide approaching the stretch and was hard ridden in the drive to wear down MER DE GLACE. The latter, close up outside front-running LAKESIDE LASSIE from early on, moved to the fore in the upper stretch while remaining off the inside, then couldn't contain the winner in the late stages. ENQUIRY WOMAN, well placed and saving ground from early on, angled four wide for the drive, loomed prominently for the last eighth but came up empty. DIXIE DAZZLE swerved out at the start, was outrun while saving ground for six furlongs, made a mild bid in the upper stretch to reach contention but lacked a further account. LAKESIDE LASSIE gained the lead early, made the pace while four wide until the stretch and weakened. COLOR ME CHROME, six or seven wide throughout, was finished upon going six furlongs. MOON CHILD raced forwardly inside until the second turn, gave way and was eased.
