Footnotes

ISLAND ECHO forced the pace early while three abreast, took over in the upper stretch, edged clear, then lasted under strong handling over CHARM. The latter, outsprinted early, raced near the inside until the stretch, angled five wide for the drive and slowly was getting to the winner. THUNDER SANDS tracked the dueling leaders from early on, raced four wide, loomed menacingly between the top two for the drive and wasn't good enough. BOO'S BRASS LADY dueled for the lead from early on while between GARDEN BEAUTY and ISLAND ECHO, put a head in front concluding the turn but weakened in the drive. BOATMAN ROAD drifted in at the start bumping FOUR SEASONS, was outrun into the stretch, made a mild bid approaching the final furlong but failed to continue. DIABLOS FIRST LADY bobbed in her second stride, settled near the inside, came out eight wide for the drive, then, after the rider dropped his whip at the eighth pole, lacked a closing bid. FOUR SEASONS, bumped at the start, tired early. RADIANT (IND) drifted out at the start, raced eight wide on the backstretch, edged in a bit around the turn and failed to menace. GARDEN BEAUTY gained a slight edge inside early, dueled with BOO'S BRASS LADY and ISLAND ECHO until the stretch and faded thereafter.
