WILD AS ELLE, slammed at the break by SACRED FEATHER, went up outside that one to force the pace in hand four wide, took over on the far turn, settled into the stretch with a clear advantage and widened under energetic handling. ROYAL BEAN, reserved early near the inside, moved five wide with a sweeping bid on the far turn, was just off the winner through the drive and couldn't menace as second best. DIANNE'S DBUT, rated three or four wide within easy striking distance, was between rivals entering the lane and was empty in the drive. LANTERN COURT followed the leaders within easy striking distance four or five wide until the final quarter and weakened thereafter. MRS. DEBBIE M, raced within striking distance near the inside to the stretch and weakened after angling four wide. SACRED FEATHER ducked out at the start soundly bumping the winner, gained a slim lead near the inside, battled with WILD AS ELLE for a half, lost the edge to the far one on the far turn and tired thereafter. MELISSA ROCKS raced four or five wide and faded.
