MOON BUZZ stalked the pace in hand, came three wide to make her bid, opened clear with a furlong to run and kept the fast closing HONCHIS'N PONCHIS at bay. HONCHIS'N PONCHIS attended the pace off of the inside, wheeled out five wide entering the stretch, finished well but was unable to reach the winner. DUST AND DIAMONDS set the pressured pace three wide, but faltered in the final furlong and faded. BACKSIDE BLACKIE was unhurried into stride, angled out entering the stretch, split horses and was making up ground. ARIENZA rushed up along the inside, disputed the pace to the stretch and faded. MEGA DREAM settled saving ground, got through entering the stretch but lacked the needed response. RIGAMARO was hustled along three wide between horses, finished with a mild rally but failed to threaten. HENNY'S HURRICANE was allowed to settle, came three wide but lacked a response when called upon. FLASK was hustled along five wide for a half and dropped out.
