DEVIL TRAIN tracked the pace three wide, assumed command leaving the turn and steadily edged clear. GRINNING GANG was pinched back at the start, settled in hand, circled five wide and finished well for the place. GOVERNOR'S BADGE stalked the pace four wide, offered a mild bid but lacked the needed late response. SOUTHERN ROCKET stumbled at the start, moved up off of the inside, was blocked entering the stretch, split horses but was bumped a furlong out, got through then took a bad step and finished evenly. HENRY'S TIME was pinched back at the start, settled near the tail of the field, came four wide and improved position. ARONEY failed to respond. STRATEGIC WEALTH opened clear to set the pace, was headed leaving the turn and gave way readily. COURT'S JOURNEY showed little in a dull effort.
