LIGHT UP THE SCORE pressed the pace three wide, challenged in earnest on the turn, drew clear into the stretch and stayed clear while kept to the task. NINJA BLADE behind the leaders three wide, lacked a late bid but was clearly second best. MAJESTIC MAN within striking distance off the inside, lacked a late bid. CALL IN RICH vied for the lead along the inside, held on well to the stretch and tired. DIAMOND BENZ prompted the pace between rivals and tired. SANTO GATO within striking distance, raced four wide late on the turn and had nothing left. CAPTAIN GOODENOUGH was no threat four wide. DATEFUL GRED was outrun. THISBIRDCANDANCE never reached contention. GRIP HANDS was through early.
