YO COLTRANE six wide early when outrun, made a run four wide on the second turn, challenged once in the stretch and drew clear under steady urging. SAVIANO behind the leaders off the inside, moved out four wide on the second turn, challenged approaching the stretch and held on gamely. MR. REALISTIC outrun for five furlongs, made a good four wide move into the stretch but had little left late. WHERE'S THE BEEF forced the pace three wide, held on well to the final furlong and tired. NUMEN LUMEN six wide early when within reach, moved in to the three path on the second turn and tired. WELL

RESPECTED MAN four wide on the first turn when forwardly placed, held on well to the stretch and tired. R FAST CAT angled in early, was no threat. BIG FLIRT alternated for the lead along the inside and faded. JAYDEE failed to menace. CITIZEN JOHN alternated for the lead off the inside and stopped. GOLD'N HOLIDAY five wide early, had speed for a half.
